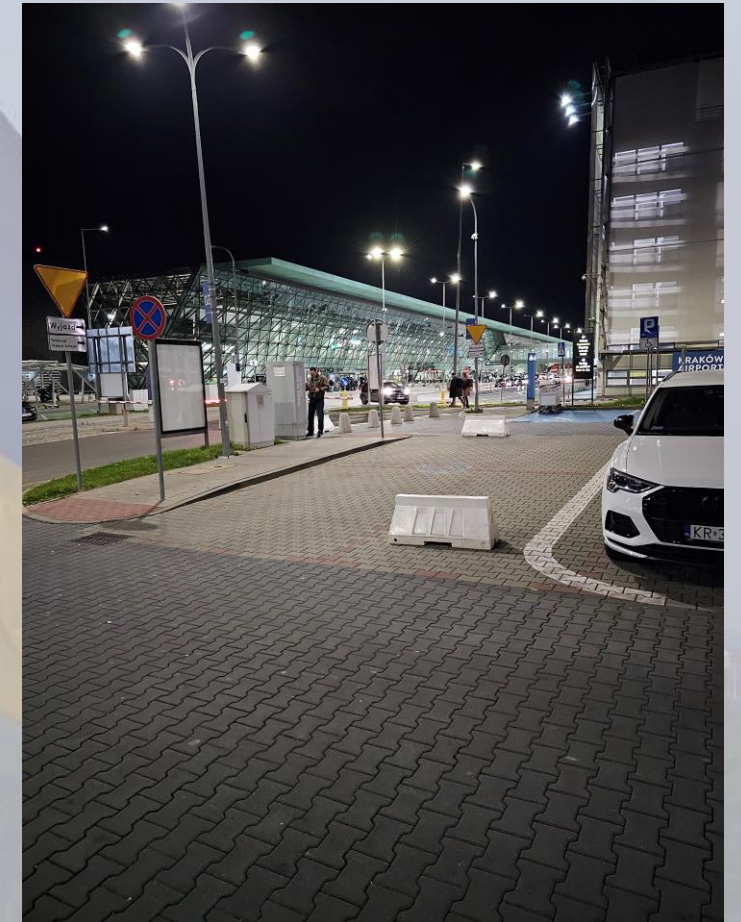

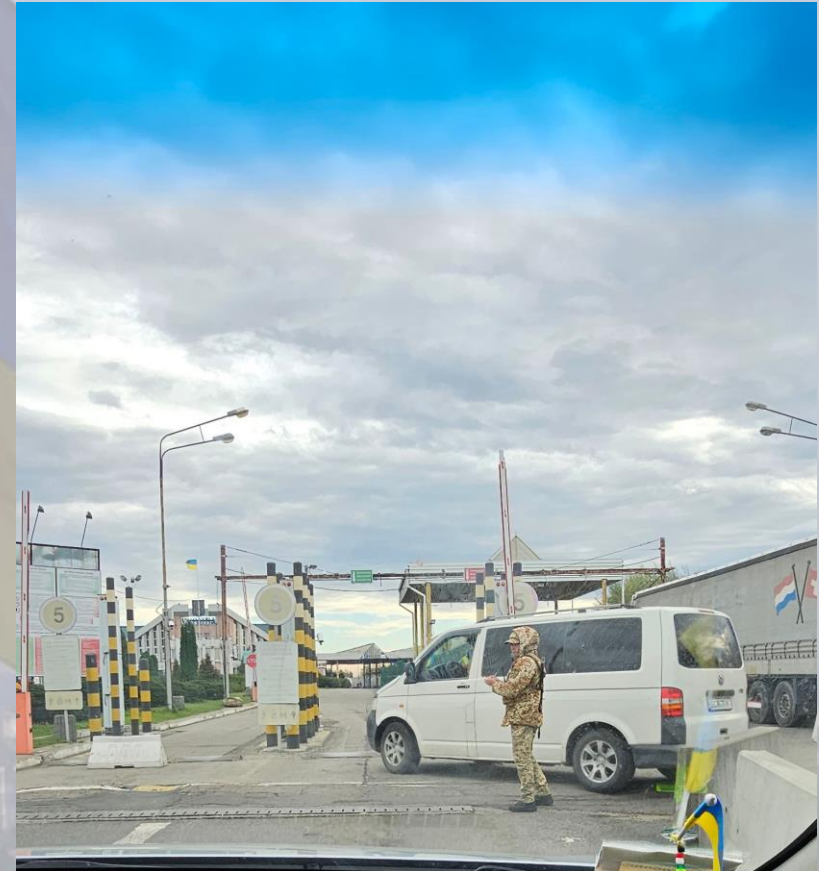

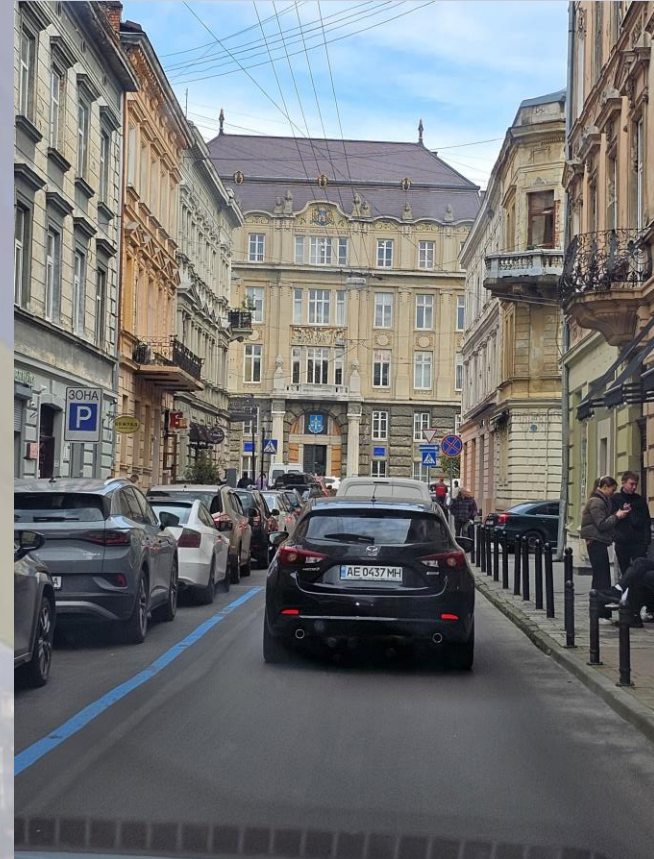
Ukraine Security check point. Amazing! It only took us about 15-20 min. When Andriy picked us up it took him 4hrs to get through border control.

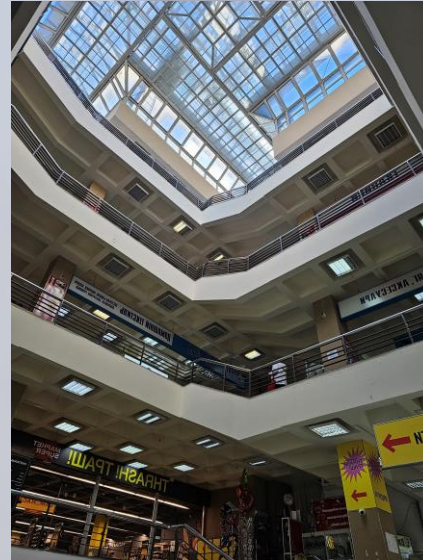

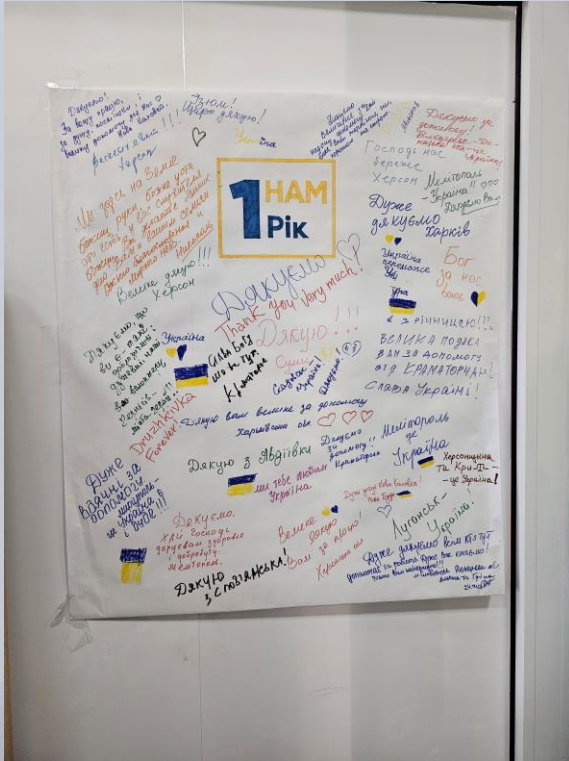

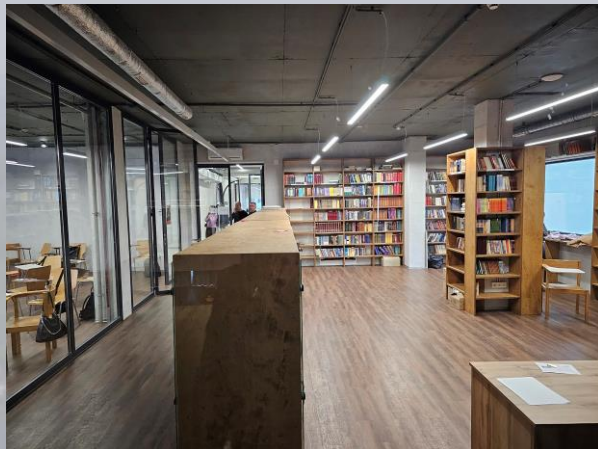

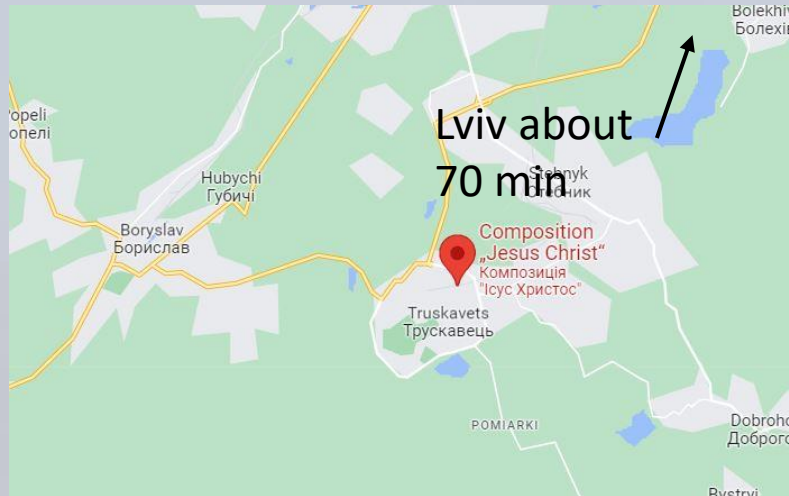

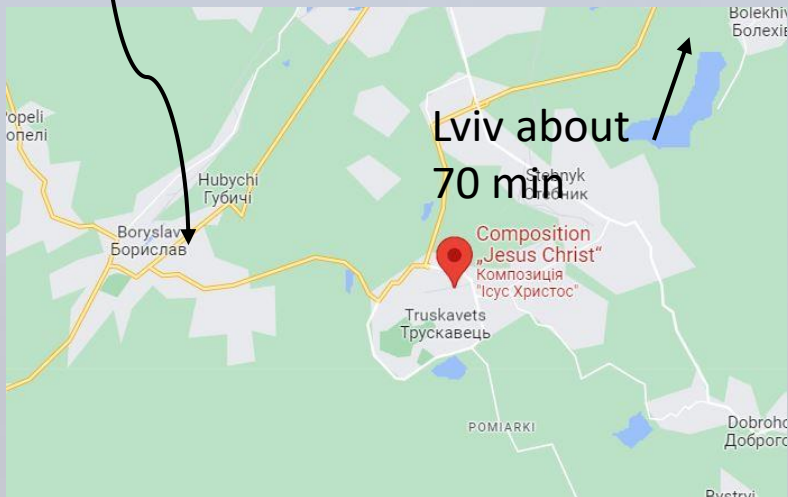

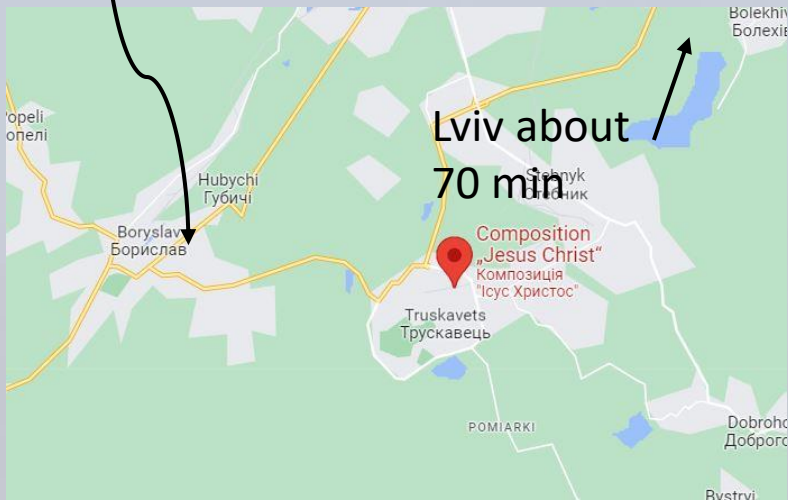

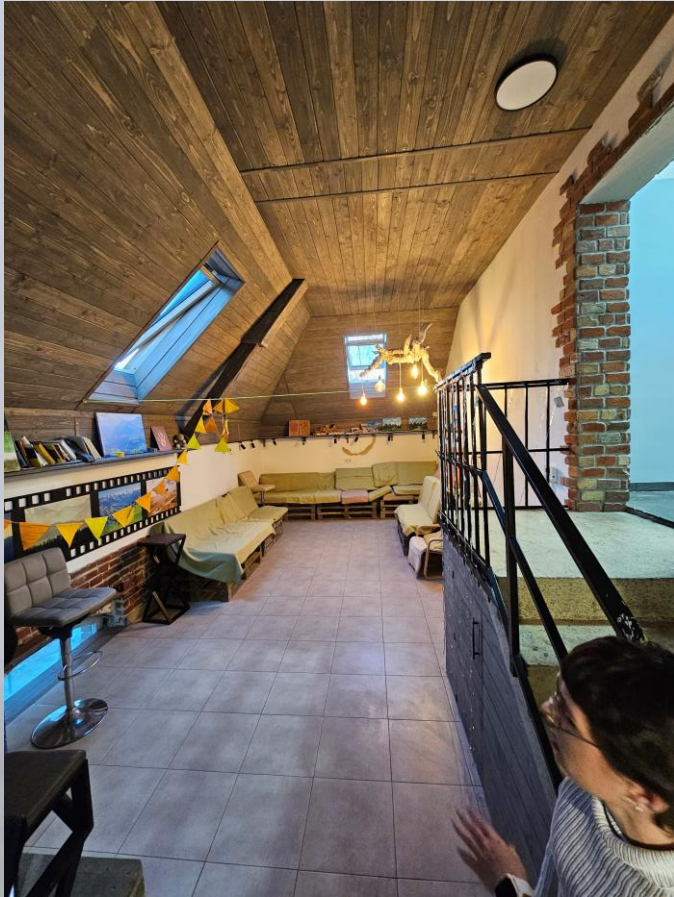

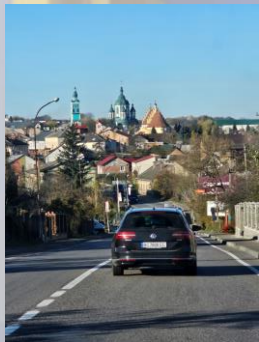
